Practical Information **About Santander**

Santander is a city of about 200,000 inhabitants with a privileged location by the sea and close to the mountains. Its climate is very mild and the whole region offers a diverse landscape with high mountain peaks, rolling green hills and beautiful coastlines.

It is a land that is different from the rest of Spain. Among its many touristic attractions, the Cantabrian coast is graced with hundreds of **fine white sand**









beaches and impressive cliffs, and the coast is less than a 2-hour drive from the breath-taking landscapes of **Picos de Europa** mountains.

The region preserves important historical remains from the Prehistoric Era, Roman ruins such as those of Julióbriga, medieval settlements such as Santillana del Mar, and several examples of the civil and religious architecture of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. Cantabria hosts some of the most impressive prehistoric caves in Europe, such as world-renowned Altamira. Just one hour drive away in neighbouring Bilbao, is the famous Guggenheim Museum.

Getting to EDUC from the Airport

A public bus runs every 30mins starting from 7h to 23h. The bus stop is located in front of the arrivals terminal and drops you off at the bus station in Santander.

Those arriving from other cities such as Bilbao or San Sebastian, the private bus company Alsa takes you directly to Santander city centre in 1 or 2h. For more information please check their website.

To get to the University of Cantabria one can take the bus 7C1 or 7C2 from the public bus company, "Autobuses Urbanos de Santander" (TUS) and drop off at the Avenida de los Castros stop. Sometimes, bus lines 3 and 4 also stop by the University. Please check the website by clicking here There is a 25 minutes walk form Santander bus station to the University Campus. For the most adventurous ones please check the map.

By Plane

Santander can be reached by plane with daily direct flights from Madrid and Barcelona. The Bilbao airport, the biggest of northern Spain, is just one hour drive away. The low-cost airline Ryanair flies from Santander into many European destinations, with affordable flights to London, Paris, Rome and many other destinations.
